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Helicopter: Our Bell Long Ranger helicopter is fitted with luxurious leather seats, BOSE aviation-grade noise-canceling headsets, heating and air-conditioning and satellite tracking. The individual seats for every passenger afford the kind of shoulder room and personal space found in airline "First Class" seating. The L206 comfortably seats 5 adult passengers each with a window seat, or 6 passengers for short scenics/joy rides.

Safety: We pride ourselves with an impeccable safety record and will provide you with a full safety briefing before your flight. Our aircraft are tracked by satellite and carry an Emergency Transmitter Locator Beacon and a comprehensive First Aid and Survival kit.

Payment: Payment on the day by cash, Visa, MasterCard or BarterCard. Mobile EFTPOS carried. To secure bookings, a 20% deposit is required. By prior arrangement, invoices will be sent out and full payment will be required by the 20th of the following month. No refund will apply to cancellations within 48 hours of booking.

10 MINUTE FLIGHTS

Fly over the city - why not check out your house! Track our beautiful coastline and check out the Sugar Loaf Islands.

Per Passenger \$110

All prices are in NZD and include GST. Minimum 2 passengers required per flight.

15 MINUTE FLIGHTS

Fly our beautiful coastline, take in the Sugar Loaf Islands, then across the surf beaches to Oakura, followed by a quick climb over the Kaitake Ranges, returning via the city centre.

Per Passenger \$150

All prices are in NZD and include GST. Minimum 2 passengers required per flight.

20 MINUTE FLIGHTS

Track from Port Taranaki to the summit. Orbit at 8,500 feet taking in the majestic views of Taranaki and beyond, before descending back to the Port.

Per Passenger \$200

All prices are in NZD and include GST. Minimum 2 passengers required per flight.

30 MINUTE FLIGHTS

View the Mt Taranaki summit and surrounding views at 8,500 feet then descend over the Pouakai and Kaitake Ranges, passing Oakura and tracking the coastline to Paritutu and the Sugar Loaf Islands, orbiting the city on the way back. Your pilot can vary the flight path, depending on your priorities.

OR

Fly the coastline taking in the surf spots. Then follow the Stony River up to the Ahukawakawa Swamp, viewing Bells Falls and the Manganui ski field, returning via the Pouakai Range and finishing over the city before landing back at the Port.

Per Person \$280

All prices are in NZD and include GST. Minimum 2 passengers required per flight.

45 MINUTE FLIGHTS

The real mountain flying experience: Similar to the 30 minute flight, this flight includes the summit of Mt Taranaki, Fantham's Peak, the Pouakai and Kaitake ranges, Stony River and Oakura, but allows for more exploration of the Egmont National Park, including the Ahukawakawa Swamp, Lake Dive and Bell's Falls. Your flight finishes by tracking the coastline to Paritutu and the Sugar Loaf Islands, and orbiting the city on the way back. Your pilot can vary the flight path, depending on your priorities - excellent for exploring Mt Egmont National Park.

OR

Fly our beautiful coastline, taking in the Sugar Loaf Islands and then fly the surf beaches past Oakura, tracking the surf spots down to Cape Egmont. Then swoop up the gullies formed by the Stony River, taking in Bells Falls and the Ahukawakawa Swamp followed by a climb over the Pouakai Ranges. To finish, check out the city from above.

OR

Depart Port Taranaki and fly north along the coast past the city, airport, Waitara, Urenui and on to the spectacular White Cliffs, returning inland to the Port.

Per Person \$420

All prices are in NZD and include GST. Minimum 2 passengers required per flight.

60 MINUTE FLIGHTS

Our 60min flight really allows us to tailor the flight to your requirements. Normally we include an "off-base" landing allowing you to stretch your legs and take in the fantastic scenery from the ground.

Some ideas...

Take your time to explore all of Mt Taranaki and the Egmont National Park, then fly the length of the Stony River for a landing at the estuary or at the nearby Cape Egmont. Returning via the coast over the famous surf beaches.

We can take in the beauty of Mt Taranaki, then fly inland along the famous Forgotten World Highway for a coffee at Kaieto Cafe - magnificent 360 degree view of the central North Island mountains and Eastern Taranaki hill country.

Or we could drop in at Mount Damper Falls: a short walk from the landing site reveals one of the highest waterfalls in the North Island. It's a spectacular sight - particularly after heavy rainfall. The falls are surrounded by native bush and spill over a horseshoe-shaped papa bluff.

Other options include a landing at Whangamomona to experience this unique "Republic" - don't forget your Republic of Whangamomona passport!

Jill and Ron at White Cliffs Organic Brewery just north of Urenui are always welcoming and happy to show you round their award-winning organic brewery.

Or we could take you for a tour of the Tawhiti Museum (north of Hawera) for an authentic glimpse of the past - life-sized exhibits and scale models. Truly fascinating.

Then of course we have miles of beautiful coastline and a landing at the Stony River estuary - one of my favourite spots - especially at sunset! Maybe to propose to that special person in your life?

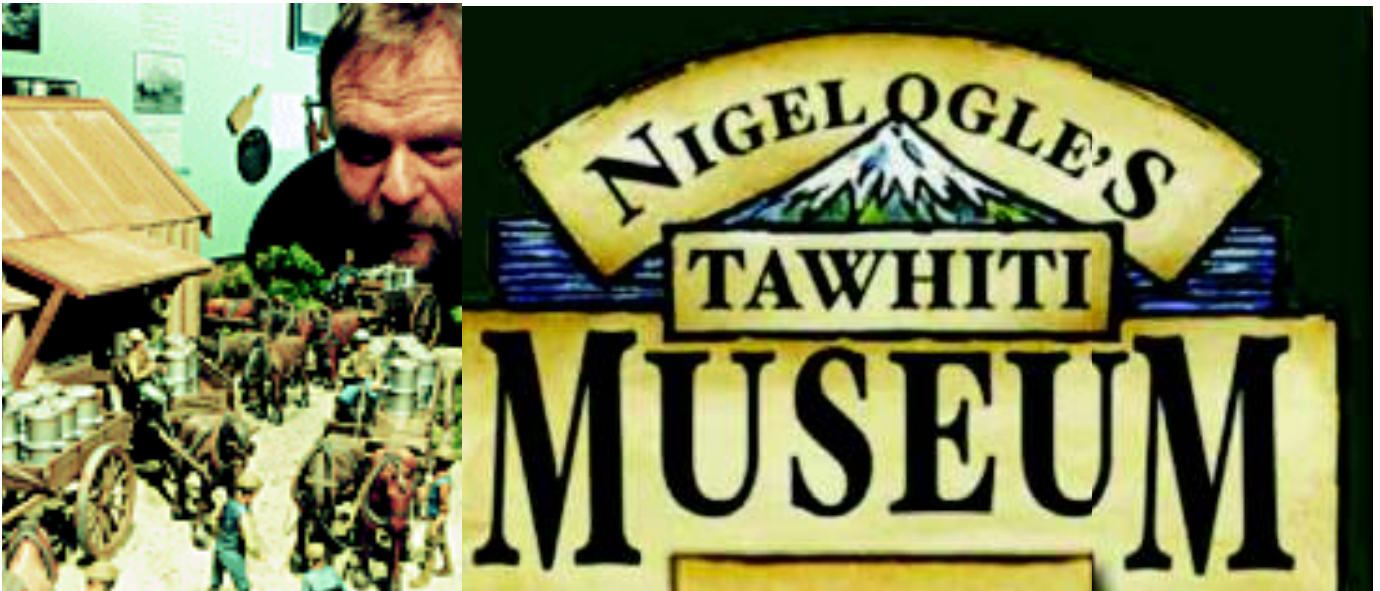

Trout Fishing

New Zealand is one of the world's premiere trout-fishing locations so it comes as a surprise (even to some New Zealanders) to learn that the trout is an introduced species to this country. New Zealand did have a native freshwater sports fish – the Grayling, regarded as good angling and excellent eating – but it became extinct soon after the introduction of the Brown Trout.

Brown and Rainbow Trout were introduced from Europe and North America respectively in the late 1800s. Having left most of their diseases and all their predators behind them, they have thrived in this country wherever conditions are suitable, while trout hatcheries ensure that even more marginal habitats remain stocked to capacity.

Brown Trout are the major trout of the rivers and streams of this country, while Rainbow Trout predominate all the lakes of the central region save Rotorua and Rotoiti, both of which contain mixed populations.

Skiing at Mt Ruapehu

If you visit New Plymouth during the winter months, you may wish to go skiing on Mt Ruapehu. A helicopter can have you on the snow in just over half an hour. Two ski resorts located on the mountain make this the largest ski field in New Zealand. Equipment can be hired at either, and ski lessons (from beginners through to advanced masters) arranged. The slopes vary from easy beginner's slopes to considerably more technical ones for the experienced skier. The ski season generally commences in June and continues as long as there is a sufficient snow base – at least as late as October.

We can fly up to 5 passengers, on condition equipment is hired from Ohakune or National Park. Only 3 passengers can be taken with own ski equipment. Either return on the same day, or, if required, we can help with a variety of accommodation to suit (additional cost).

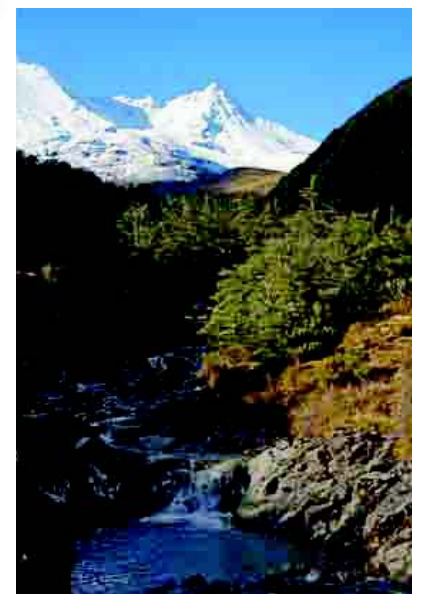

The Powderhorn is one of the premier accommodation facilities in the Ruapehu district. Located in Ohakune, the hotel combines the ambience of a traditional European ski chalet with the comfort of a luxury hotel. The Powderhorn Chateau provides an ideal base for those wishing to explore this stunning alpine wonderland, one of only a handful of sites throughout the world to be given dual natural and cultural World Heritage status by UNESCO.

The Powderhorn's story began back when Paul Scarf developed the Powderhorn Ski and Board shop, which opened in 1987, and from this shop grew the Powderkeg Restaurant.

The Powderkeg exploded into life during the late 1980s and early 1990s, with an innovative menu of foods prepared on sizzling hot rocks and its own special Powderkeg beer. It has since built a reputation as a hugely popular après-ski venue, and THE place to be on a night out in Ohakune.

Extensions took place in 1995 with the hotel, the Matterhorn Restaurant and two conference rooms built onto the original building. The Powderhorn Chateau was thus born. The original hospitality and warmth remain today, and the Powderhorn Chateau is now a favourite haven for skiers, outdoor enthusiasts, business people, film crews and for those who simply seek a place to relax and enjoy themselves.
